This is the month to see the large Hawker Dragonflies. Although they are not numerous, they can be seen all around the site, particularly hunting for other insects along the site paths. The two most common species are the Southern Hawker and the Common Hawker, but you can occasionally see the unmistakable 'brown all over' Brown Hawker.

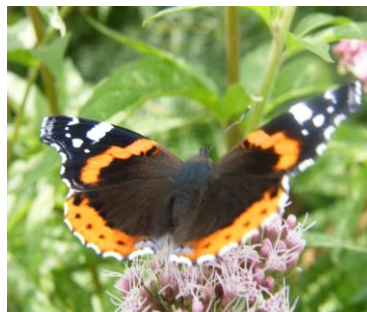
